Player Pool

- Explain how player pool will work
 - If a player is listed on the player pool they may be contacted (possibly short notice) to play for a team that is short a player.
 - Reasoning for player pool According to Little league international rules a player cannot just be Borrowed from the opposing team to complete a game.
 - Board Member on duty will go down the list and contact players until a player is identified to play. Player pool will go down the full list before starting over, offering each player listed an opportunity to fill in.
 - Text messages will be used as the most efficient means of communicating to players on the pool.
 - Minor pool Eligible for Minors and T-shirt players
 - Major Pool eligible for Major and Minors players
 - If selected, pool players are ineligible to pitch or catch and Must play 9 defensive outs and bat once.
- Identify Players wanting to be in the Player Pool
 - Have parents write down player name, current team, Cell # to text. On the appropriate player pool sheet located in the meeting room.

Minor's Rules

- Stealing
 - Can steal once the ball has crossed the front plane of home plate. **No Leading Off
 - Runners May advance until ball is dead (Ruled by umpire) or in pitchers hand
 - Recommend that early in season "home plate is closed" for stealing on passed balls. Discussion among coaches prior to each game on preferences. Shifts the focus to putting the ball in play.
- Baseball Pitch counts (Age 9-10 75 pitches per day max)
 - o If a player pitches 66 or more pitches in a day, four (4) calendar days of rest must be observed.
 - If a player pitches 51-65 pitches in a day, three (3) calendar days of rest must be observed.
 - If a player pitches 36-50 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed.
 - If a player pitches 21-35 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar days of rest must be observed.
 - If a player pitches 1-20 pitches in a day, no (0) calendar day of rest is required.
 - Exception: If a pitcher reaches a day(s) of rest threshold while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until any one of the following conditions occurs: (1) that batter reaches base; (2) that batter is retired; or (3) the third out is made to complete the half-inning or the game. The pitcher will only be required to observe the calendar day(s) of rest for the threshold he/she reached during that at-bat, provided that pitcher is removed or the game is completed before delivering a pitch to another batter.
- Any player who has played the position of catcher in four (4) or more innings in a game is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day.

Major Specific Rules Baseball

Dropped 3rd strike

- The batter becomes a runner when -The third strike is not caught, providing that 1)- First base is unoccupied or 2)- first base is occupied with two outs.
- Not in play if: A third strike is not caught by the catcher when first base is occupied before there are two outs.

Practices

- Before games start:
 - Maximum: 3-1.5hr sessions
 - Minimum: 2 1.5 hr sessions
- Once games start:
 - Maximum 2 1.5hr Sessions
 - Minimum: 1 1.5 hr session
- Practice
 - Schedule Build a practice plan that breaks down stations and how long you'll do each station. Break players into groups and keep them active.
 - Have access to team contacts in case a parent is late (no child can be left unattended for any reason)
- Assign Homework
 - Play catch at home
 - Watch baseball
 - Go through the fundamental motions of hitting and throwing
